

## **Conflict Minerals Statement**

AAA Air Support is committed to the responsible sourcing of materials used in our products and throughout our supply chain. We support the humanitarian goal of ending violence and human rights abuses associated with the extraction of certain minerals in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and surrounding regions.

In accordance with the requirements of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 and the related rules adopted by the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), “conflict minerals” refer to tin, tungsten, tantalum, and gold (3TG), regardless of where they are mined, processed, or sold. Additional minerals may be designated by the U.S. Secretary of State in the future.

Although AAA Air Support does not directly file reports with the SEC, we recognize that many of our customers do and therefore require supply-chain transparency. We are committed to:

- Supporting conflict-free sourcing of 3TG minerals
- Working with our suppliers to ensure responsible supply chain practices
- Responding to customer requests for Conflict Minerals Reporting Templates (CMRT)
- Maintaining compliance with applicable regulations and industry expectations

AAA Air Support will continue to monitor our supply base and maintain documentation consistent with our quality system and customer requirements.
